### **Travel Designed For Movement.**

#### **Rules :**

##### **Team Composition**

Each team shall consist of three amateur players and one professional player.

##### **Handicap**

Handicaps shall be applied in accordance with the World Handicap System (WHS) and capped as follows: a maximum of thirty (30) for women and twenty-five (25) for men.

##### **Handicap Adjustment**

The organizing committee reserves the right to adjust the handicap of any amateur player during the competition if deemed necessary, in particular based on observed performance, in order to ensure fairness and preserve the integrity of the event.

##### **Tees**

The competition shall be played from the following tees: professional players from the blue tees, amateur men from the white tees, and amateur women from the red tees.

##### **Stableford Scoring System**

Points shall be awarded according to the Stableford system, as follows: Bogey: 1 point; Par: 2 points; Birdie: 3 points; Eagle: 4 points.

##### **Team Net Classification**

On each hole, the three best net scores within the team shall be counted, including both amateur and professional players. Net scores are calculated by applying handicap strokes in accordance with each player's handicap and the stroke index of the hole. Teams shall be ranked based on the total number of points accumulated over the competition. The team achieving the highest total shall be declared the winner of the Net classification. Second and third ranked teams shall also be awarded.

##### **Team Gross Classification**

On each hole, the two best gross scores within the team shall be counted, including both amateur and professional players. Teams shall be ranked based on the total number of points accumulated over the competition. The team achieving the highest total shall be declared the winner of the Gross classification.

##### **Tie-Break Procedure**

In the event of a tie in either the Net or Gross team classifications, teams shall be separated by applying a countback method in the following order: the last 9 holes (holes 10-18), then the last 6 holes (holes 13-18), then the last 3 holes (holes 16-18), and finally the 18th hole.

#### **Professional Classification**

The professional ranking shall be determined based on individual gross stroke play over the entire competition. In the event of a tie, players shall be separated using the same countback method as defined above.

#### **Prizes**

Prizes shall be awarded to the following categories: first Team Gross, first Team Net, second Team Net, and third Team Net. Individual prizes shall also be awarded to the first, second, and third professional players. Additional on-course contests shall include nearest to the pin and longest drive at each course, reserved for amateur players.
